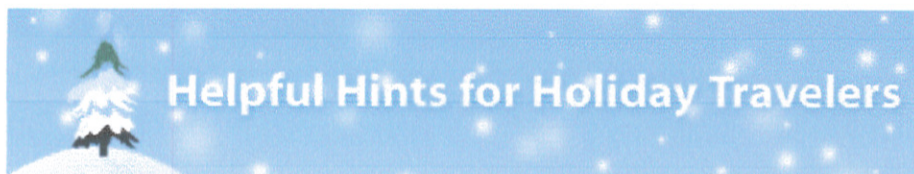

El Paso, Texas—Tuesday, December 20, 2011, -El Paso International Airport (EPIA) would like to encourage passengers to arrive at least 2 hours before departure during the 2011 Holiday season. Early arrival time is necessary in order to allow adequate time to facilitate the screening process handled by the Transportation Security Administration.

The airport recommends that all passengers review TSA's policies on liquids and on prohibited items for carry-on bags. For passenger convenience, zip-top bags are available at the base of the escalators.
